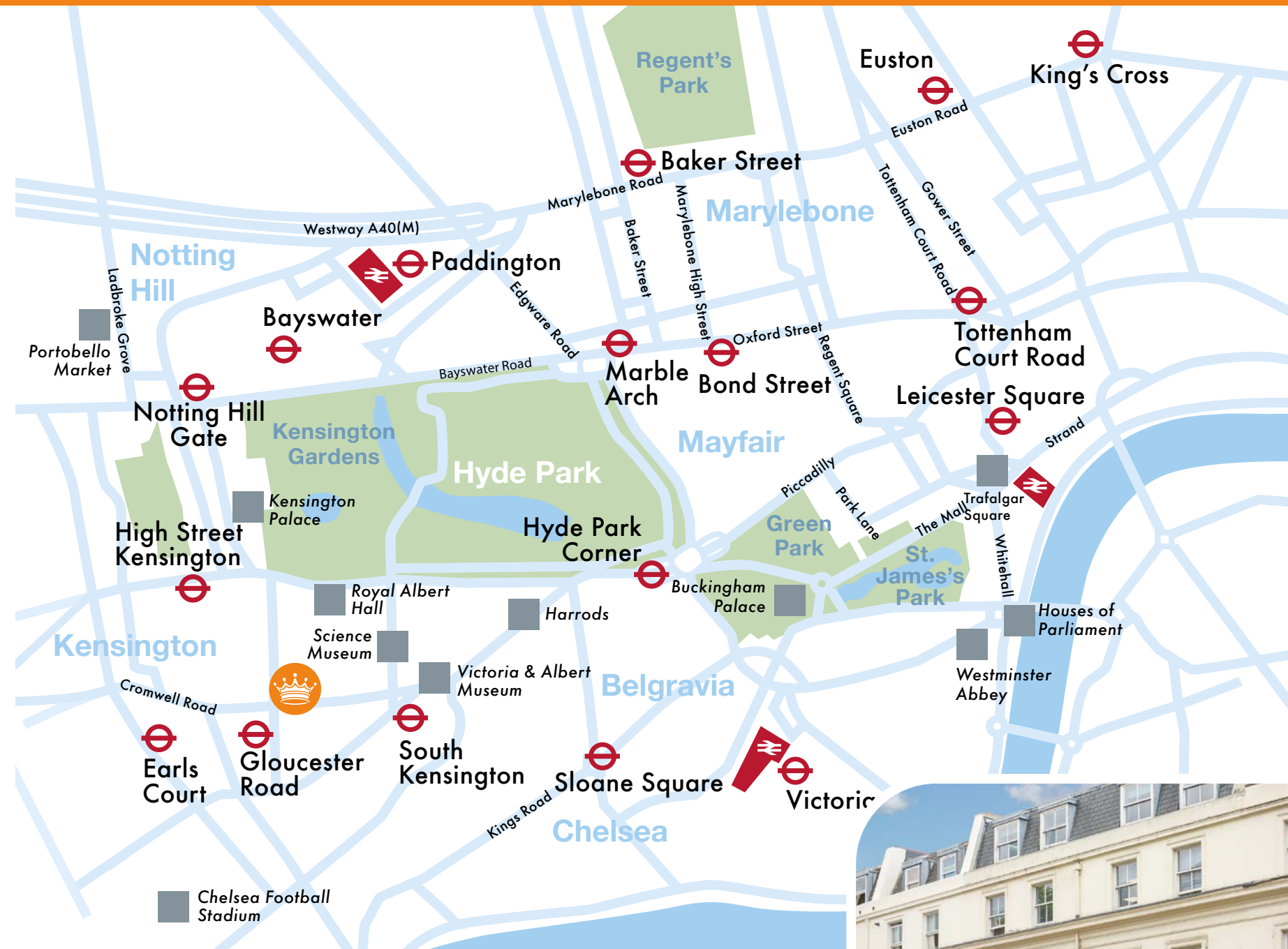
London Family Programme

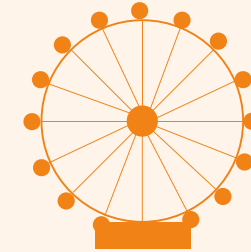
Activity Programme for Families

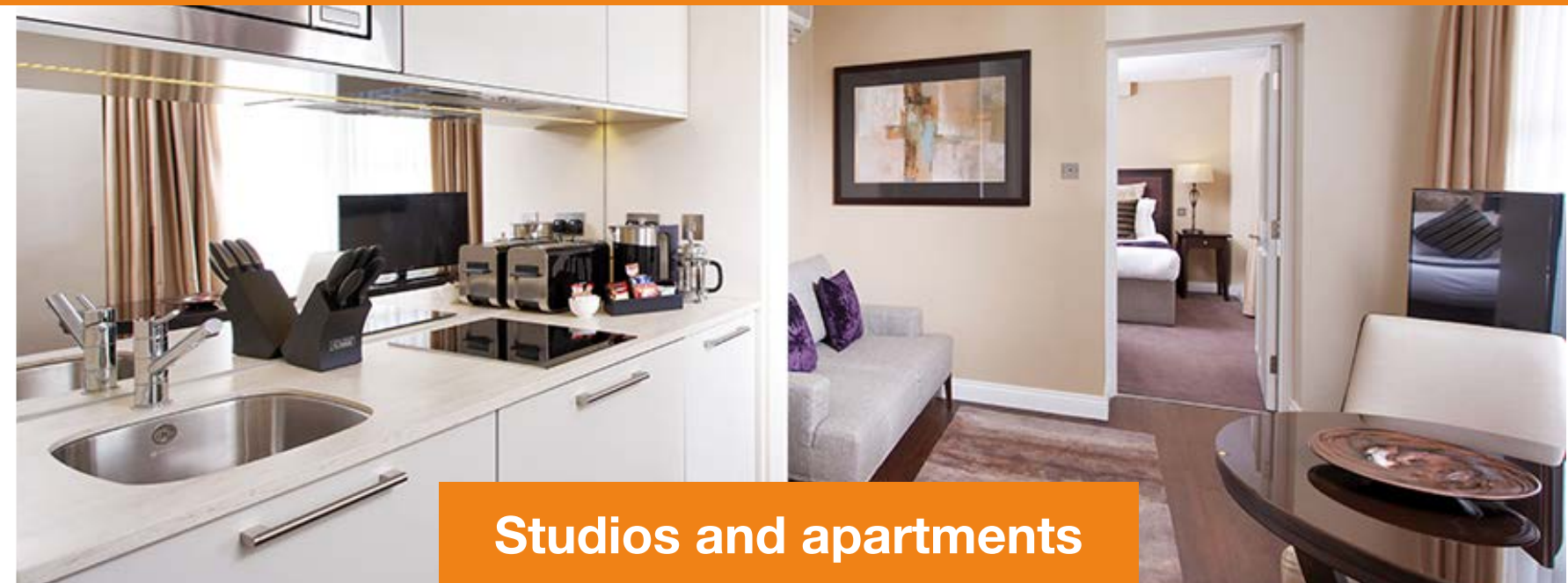

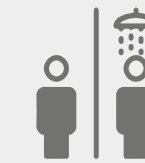

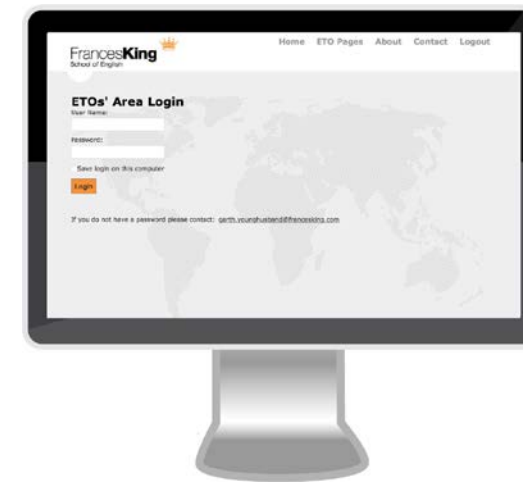
