# Family Junior Day School Activity Programme 2025

## What you need to know



- All events start at the school.
- Students must meet in the Common Room at the published start time. Students must not be late. If students are late we will leave without the student, who will have to stay in the school until collected by their parent or guardian. No alternative trip, refund or compensation will be offered.
- All students must wear Frances King identification while on any trip.
- All students should carry a mobile phone for security reasons.
- The leader will need to have a record of this number for emergencies – so if the student changes their number, this new number must be passed on to staff.
- The leader must be informed about any relevant medical conditions.
- We will always respect a student's privacy, but leaders must know about any medical conditions that may affect a student while on a trip, in order to offer the best care and security for the student.
- While on trips, students will be travelling by public transport.
- Students will need to have a Travelcard or Oystercard to cover them for the entire trip. We advise that as well as having a Travelcard for zones 1 & 2, all students should have a pay-as-you-go credit for £20 to cover any errors, such as forgetting to renew a weekly card, or travelling outside the zones covered by the travelcard. Any unused credit can be refunded at any underground station at the end of your stay in London.
- Students must listen to the leaders' instructions at all times.
- If students misbehave and endanger their own security or someone else's, they may be prohibited from joining further trips. No alternatives, refund or compensation will be offered.
- All events end back at the school.
- Parents/guardians should be at the school at 5pm to collect students.
- Students over 14 may leave on their own if we have received written permission from their parent/guardian.
- Students must always return to the school with the group and cannot leave earlier in the journey, unless we have a specific and unique request in writing from the parent or guardian for that particular trip – eg if the return journey passes through the student's home destination station. Each request will be considered on a case-by-case basis and must be approved by the Centre Manager in advance.
