Accommodation Description

The studios have double beds, table and chairs for working and dining, a flat-screen TV and a safe. They are approximately 18-20m2. There is a microwave, cooker hob, refrigerator, toaster, kettle and washing machine with dryer. Kitchen utensils are also provided. The apartments benefit from a kitchen (mostly open plan) and lounge area and are suitable for up to three people in a one-bed apartment or 4 people in a two-bed (both with use of a sofa-bed). Rooms have double beds (twin beds on request in the apartments, subject to availability). Modern, en-suite bathroom facilities in every room (shower, sink & WC).

Cleaning, linen and laundry

Maid service every 2 days (except bank holidays) and linen/ towel change every 6 days. Towels are included and extra set available for £10/set (1 big towel and 1 small towel). Extra cleaning available on request at an additional charge (£30-£90 depending on the apartment size).

Visitors / Guests

You need to notify Chelsea Cloisters if you are expecting visitors to stay within your apartment, along with their dates of arrival and departure and full name. Extra linen charges may apply, check with reception.

Noise / Restrictions

Students are requested to keep noise levels to a minimum especially after 22:00. Smoking/vaping is strictly forbidden inside the building. Anyone who is caught smoking will be asked to leave the property and be charged a penalty of £200 for breaching the house rules. No refunds are given to students who have to leave for disciplinary reasons.



Chelsea Cloisters serviced apartments are situated in Chelsea, one of London's most fashionable, vibrant areas, bordered by Knightsbridge, Sloane Square, South Kensington and Fulham, all in travel zone 1. Damage / Deposit

Notice / Cancellation

After Arrival: No refund is given if a stay is shortened or cancelled. The Frances King cancellation fee of £75 is also payable in case of cancellation after arrival.

(1-2 people, 1 double bed):

January - April 30: £134/night; From May 1: £186/night

1-bedroom apartment

(1–3 people, double bed & sofa bed in living room): January - April 30: £168/night; From May 1: £217/night

2-bedroom apartment

(2-4 people, 1 double bed, 1 single bed and sofa bed in living room):

January - April 30: £325/night; From May 1: £378/night

From June-September the minimum stay for Two-bed apartments is 2 weeks.
