

#### **LOCATION**

Parents and their children study in our main Kensington school, opposite Gloucester Road underground station, except in the summer, when parents study in a nearby annexe - a 4 minute walk away.



#### **AGES**

Children of 6-16 years are accepted in winter, spring, summer and autumn. Children of 5 years are also accepted in the summer. Children of 8-16 years are accepted on the Family Junior and Afternoon Club in winter, 8-11 years in summer. Children of 12-16 years are accepted on the Day School Programme in summer. A parent or guardian of a child of 5 or 6 years, must either take a course or remain in the school during lesson times. The minimum age for an adult in charge is 21.

### **London Family Programme Courses**

#### **Family Junior Morning**

This fun, dynamic and stimulating course is designed for young learners of all ages, with an emphasis on spoken English and communication, through imaginative activities and group project work. Teachers use a mix of interactive games, videos, and other resources and activities within lessons.

#### Children will:

- Enhance their proficiency in all four language skills: listening, reading, writing, and speaking
- Improve pronunciation and fluency in spoken English
- Expand their English vocabulary
- Build confidence in speaking and develop skills to communicate more effectively
- Visit a local place of interest, each week, as part of a class project

#### **Family Adult**

While their children are at school, parents and other family members have the option of taking a course at Frances King too. During the summer, parents may join a 30+ English Programme. Parents can join an Intensive Programme, if their children take either the Junior & Afternoon Club or Day School. There is also an afternoon only option for a parent not able to study in the morning.

#### **Adults will:**

- Enhance their proficiency in all four language skills: listening, reading, writing, and speaking
- Improve pronunciation, fluency and accuracy in spoken English
- Expand their English vocabulary and increase knowledge of grammar, vocabulary and colloquial phrases
- Build confidence in speaking and develop skills to communicate more effectively
- Gain valuable networking opportunities with other learners

### Family Junior Day School (Summer only)

This all day programme is for ages 12-16 in summer. Participants join the Family Junior Morning Course and in the afternoon there are activities, excursions and projects, on 5 afternoons a week. Children should be dropped off at 8.45 and collected at 17.00. Students must bring a packed lunch and a travel card.

### Family Junior & Afternoon Club (Summer and winter only)

This programme is for ages 8-16 in winter and 8-11 in summer. Participants join the Family Junior Morning Course and in the afternoon there are activities, in the school, such as arts, crafts and games, on 5 afternoons / week. Groups are mixed levels and ages. Children should be dropped off at 8.45 and collected at 15.30. Students must bring a packed lunch.





#### **PAYMENT**

You must send payment with your enrolment. We can confirm your course or accommodation booking and send a letter of confirmation when you or your company have paid:

- Registration fee of £130 per family and a deposit per person of
  - £250 if you want to book a course
  - £600 if you want to book a course and accommodation
    - 21 days before your arrival you need to pay the balance of your course and accommodation fees
    - Deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable
- · Payment in full, in the following cases:
  - If you are applying for a Student Visa
  - If you are booking less than 21 days before arrival
    - Documents for visa applications will not be issued unless. students have paid course and accommodation fees in full

#### **CONFIRMATION**

When we receive your Enrolment Form and payment, we check the availability of your course and accommodation and send your confirmation documents by email or post within 3-4 working days. We can also send your documents by courier (DHL): £45/courier. We will contact you if the course or accommodation you want is not available and offer you an alternative.

If you would like us to arrange accommodation before your pre-entry visa is issued, you need to agree to our Accommodation Cancellation Policy, otherwise we will not arrange your accommodation until a visa has been issued.

If you want to book an airport transfer (either a single or return) you must email us your flight details and phone number. We will then confirm that we have booked this for you.

You must inform your homestay or other accommodation provider of your arrival time. If you do not do this, we cannot guarantee that your host/ accommodation provider will be there to meet you.

#### **INSURANCE**

Before you arrive in the UK, you should take out insurance for your own financial and personal security. EU nationals should bring their European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) which allows you access to health care services
