2 TATE BRITAIN

The history of British art from the 15th century to modern, with the world's largest collection of JMW Turner. Highly recommended!

5 HORIZON 22

London's newest, and highest, viewing platform, atop the 22 Bishopsgate skyscraper. The view of London from here is absolutely breathtaking and is a must-see. Plus, unlike the Shard (which is £25), it's absolutely free!!

6 QUEENSWAY BOWLING

11 THE WALLACE COLLECTION

The Wallace Collection is an absolute must-see in London. An extensive collection of fine and decorative arts, including paintings, sculptures, furniture, and arms in an 18th century town house. **Price: free. Meet outside school at 3:30 pm.**



12 SIR JOHN SOANE'S MUSEUM

The house and massive antique collection of this famous 17th century London architect has to be seen to be believed! Highly recommended.

13 RIVER THAMES UBER FERRY

Forget the expensive tourist boats, every Londoner knows that the cheapest and best way to see the River Thames is on an Uber ferry boat. We will travel along the river from Westminster to Greenwich, taking in the magnificent views as we go!

14 ANDERSON TOURS: COTSWOLDS DAY TOUR
